
Multimedia Journalism (JOU4500A_155632) No. of responses = 8









Histogram for scaled questions



- 3.1) Comment on aspects of the instructor's teaching style that helped the learning process.
- I really liked how he would have us critically think about our own questions before he would answer.
- Kelly is a fantastic instructor, arguably one of the best I've had at Elon. He is beyond flexible and adaptive while encouraging learning and fostering community and engagement. Kelly always gives excellent feedback, which has profoundly improved my work. He also deeply cares about his students, and that is shown in his class.
- Loved how this course went so beyond journalism- all of the mini lessons on databases, visuals, 360 photo and video, etc. were so, so helpful.
- Self-grading works well for a class like this. I also like that it is just the two projects and nothing else to worry about. This was very helpful as all my attention was on making the projects as good as they could possibly be instead of worrying about other small assignments along the way.
- The class lessons were always thorough and genuinely helpful. I am leaving this class with a lot more knowledge about each aspect of multimedia journalism.
- Very organized and always has great class activities that relate to the material.
- 3.2) Comment on aspects of the instructor's teaching style that could be improved upon to help the learning process.
- Giving us more time in class to work on our stories and get direct feedback from him.
- I think perhaps the biggest issue I found was that it just feels like there's a general lack of care for students. If you're going to mark a student as at risk, shouldn't there be some sort of concern communicated to that student? The deadlines felt unrealistic considering all that was being asked for, and the pacing of assignments was not even in the first half versus the second half of the semester. And while the inclass lessons were helpful, it just seemed odd to have them spread throughout the semester when the stories are due at the halfway and end points. It would have been nice to learn about certain things earlier so that it could be applied to the first story. I just wish things had been done differently.
- Kelly is a great instructor. I think more class time could have been reserved to work on our two projects. Sometimes, especially near deadlines, it was stressful to have class discussions when it would have been nice to have in-class work time. But that is a minuscule critique, as I do not have many for Kelly.
